

## Information for asylum seekers and persons with „Duldung“

### Working in Landkreis Garmisch-Partenkirchen

**The money you get from the foreigners office is not enough for you? Would you like to move into your own apartment or simply pursue a meaningful occupation?**

**Then a job or apprenticeship is perfect for you!**

#### **What advantages do I have if I work or do an apprenticeship?**

- depending on how much you work, you get significantly more money
- if you earn enough and have a passport, you can move into your own apartment
- you get a much better health insurance if you work more than on a mini job basis (520€)
- you can pursue a meaningful occupation and contribute to society
- you can learn German at work
- if you successfully complete an apprenticeship, you have a good chance of getting a residence permit

#### **When can I work or start an apprenticeship?**

- Between the third and ninth month after you applied for asylum or the issuance of the proof of arrival, the decision is at the discretion of the foreigner's office, Garmisch-Partenkirchen and the Federal Employment Agency (Bundesagentur für Arbeit) must agree.

- Nine months after you have submitted your asylum application or the proof of arrival has been issued, you are entitled to a work permit (Section 61 (1) sentence 2 AsylG) if
- the Federal Employment Agency has approved
- you do not come from a safe country of origin,
- and your asylum application has not been rejected as obviously unfounded or inadmissible
- if you have a Duldung, the decision about work is at the discretion of the immigration office. You always need a passport in this case.

#### **At discretion, the following examples are positively evaluated:**

- you have proven your identity
- you have a valid passport
- you were involved in the asylum procedure
- you have special integration skills, for example you speak German very well

#### **In the case of discretion, the following examples are rated negatively (Section 61 (2) Asylum Act):**

- Your application for asylum has been rejected
- a Dublin procedure has been initiated for you
- you have committed a crime
- you have not proven your identity
- you don't have a passport
- Your place of work is far away from your place of residence

#### **Which documents do we need from you?**

- In all cases, we require your employer to fill out the „*Erklärung zum Beschäftigungsverhältnis*“ form in full.

#### **How to get the formular?**

1. you can pick it up at our office,
2. download it from the website of Landratsamt Garmisch-Partenkirchen under Formulare → Migration & Personenstand
3. or request it digitally via email

- the employment or apprenticeship contract

#### **When am I not allowed to work or start an apprenticeship?**

- If you are coming from one of the following countries:

Albania, Bosnia und Herzegovina, Ghana, Kosovo, Macedonia, Montenegro, Senegal, Serbia

- if less than three months have passed since you applied for asylum or the proof of arrival was issued

- if you have a „Duldung“ and there is an absolute ban on employment according to Section 60 (6) AufenthaltG

- if you already have a „Duldung“, you can usually no longer start an apprenticeship
